Costs

League Structure

Format

- **Duration:** 12 weeks, 9 holes per week, with partner
- **Scoring:** Stroke Play, Combined Net Scores
- 1 Hour time slot to play 9 Holes each week with Partner
- Playing with another team for 2 hours is encouraged!

Scheduling

- **Flexibility:** If you can't make your scheduled time, you can reschedule for free anytime Monday Friday during the 12-week league. Just mention your team's name at check-in. For Individual makeup-30 minutes allotted. For Team makeup- 1 Hour allotted.
- Weekend Makeups: Allowed, but the hourly rate applies.

Tee Placement

League tee boxes are as follows:

- **Green Tees:** Women and Juniors (under 14)
- **Red Tees:** Men (over 65)
- White/Blue Tees: Men (under 65), based on course length

Once Total Gross hits these Benchmarks your tee box will go back:

- -20 to -29 (Back One Tee Box)
- -30 to -39 (Back Two Tee Boxes)
- -40 to ~ (Back Three Tee Boxes Tips)

Handicap and Divisions

- Weeks 1-4: Establish handicaps, with teams placed into 3 divisions based on total strokes.
- Week 5-12: Net scoring starts; handicaps adjust weekly.

Handicapping Scoring Explained

Establishing Your Handicap:

- Weeks 1-4: These are play-in weeks where each player's scores are used to establish a handicap and tee box.
- **Divisions:** After Week 4, teams are divided into three divisions based on total team strokes.

Calculating Handicap Adjustments:

- Weekly Adjustment: Handicaps are recalculated each week to ensure fair competition.
- **Maximum Adjustment:** To prevent "sandbagging," handicaps can only increase by a maximum of 4 strokes per week.
- **Scratch Players:** Players who consistently score par or better will have a minimum handicap of +2 (TBD), even if they score below par. Their handicap only adjusts if they score above par. Tee Box placement will help narrow the field even more- the goal is to get rid of outliers.

Handicap Calculation Example (Par 36 Course):

- 1. **Initial Handicap:** Assume your initial handicap after Weeks 1-4 is 4.
- 2. Week 4 Performance: You shoot a score of 44 on a par 36 course, which is 8 strokes over par.
- 3. New Handicap Calculation:
 - O Add your current handicap to the number of strokes over par: 4 (current handicap) + 8 (strokes over par) = 12.
 - o Divide the result by 2 to find your new handicap: 12 / 2 = 6.
- 4. Net Score Calculation:
 - Subtract your new handicap from your actual score: 44 (actual score) 6 (handicap) = 38.
 - o Your net score for Week 4 is 38, which is 2 strokes over the course par (36).

Rounding Rules:

- **Rounding Down:** If you shoot under your handicap, your handicap for the next week rounds down to the nearest whole number.
- Rounding Up: If you shoot over your handicap, your handicap rounds up.

Substitute Players:

• Scores from substitute players only count if they are better than the absent player's established handicap.

This system ensures fair play and adjusts based on individual performance, allowing for a competitive yet enjoyable experience for all participants.
